Racquetball Rules

The Game

- 1. The current American Amateur Racquetball Association Rules will govern play except where modified herein.
- 2. Play dates will be established by the Department of University Recreation. Players/teams must make every effort to play their matches before the established deadline. If a player cannot reach his/her opponent, contact the Recreation Office at 793-4849. An Intramural staff member will immediately try to contact the opponent. If the staff member cannot reach the opponent, a win will be recorded for the participant.
- 3. Players will be responsible for reserving the racquetball courts. To reserve a court Department of University Recreation at 793-4849 any other time.

Equipment

1. Participants are encouraged to provide their own equipment; however, there are racquetball racquets, balls, and safety goggles available for checkout from the University Recreation Department. NOTE: SAFETY GOGGLES ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.

Scoring

1. The first side winning two games wins a match. A game is won by the first side scoring 15-points. The third game, or tiebreaker, will be played to only 11-points.

Co-Rec. Competition

1. Males must begin their turn of service by serving to the male opponent first. At no time may they serve twice in succession to the female opponent.

Protest

- 1. If during the competition a disagreement arises regarding the interpretation of a rule or eligibility, the decision of the Intramural Director will be final.
