<u>Tennis Rules</u>

The Game

- 1. The current United States Tennis Association Rules will govern play except where modified herein.
- 2. Play dates will be established by the Department of University Recreation.
- 3. A championship t-shirt will be awarded to the winner of each division: Men's, Women's, Doubles, and Mixed.

Equipment

- 1. Participants are encouraged to provide their own equipment; however, there are tennis racquets and balls available for checkout from the Department of Intramurals and Recreation.
- 2. During all championship matches new game balls will be provided.

Scoring

- 1. A match will consist of the best two-out-of-three sets to six games. A player who first wins six games wins a set, except that he/she must win by a margin of two games over his/her opponent (7 game cap).
- 2. Each game will be 4-points, no deuce (the first player/team to win 4-points wins the game).

Protests

- 1. If during the competition a disagreement arises regarding the interpretation of a rule or eligibility, the decision of the Director of University Recreation will be final.
- 2. The Director of University Recreation reserves the right to alter or change any of the above with the best interest of all concerned.

Scheduling Matches

- 1. Schedules will be posted on campus bulletins as well as the intramural bulletin and on UREC Social Media Pages.
- 2. There will be a deadline date scheduled for each game. It will be the responsibility of each player to contact their opponent and schedule a time to play their game before the deadline date. If a player cannot reach their opponent, come by the intramural office and inform a UREC staff member. The department will try to contact the person. If the person cannot be contacted, a forfeit will be declared.
- 3. It will be the responsibility of the winner of the games to report their scores to the University Recreation Department.
