## BEHRENS CHAPEL TIMELINE

1911 A small, humble wooden building was erected to serve as a dedicated gathering place.

## 1928

A formal structure, now known as the Original Chapel was constructed.

### : 1946

The Original Chapel was renovated and renamed as Behrens Chapel after W.J. Behrens, former president of the Board of Trustees.

# 1957

The Original Behrens Chapel was destroyed in a fire.

#### Today's Behrens Chapel Auditorium was built with the addition of Van Ellis Theatre.
