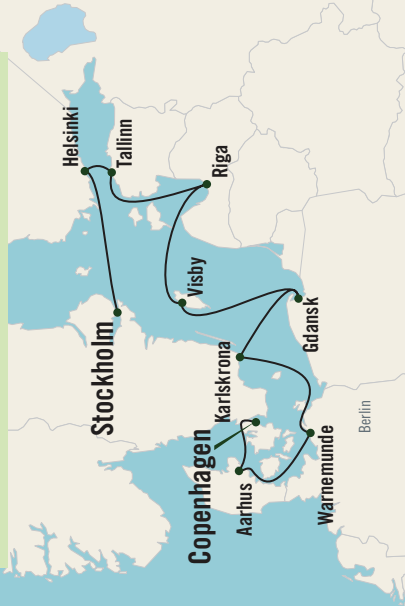

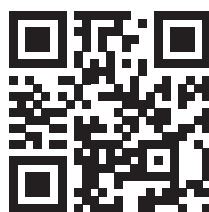

July 15: Stockholm, Sweden - Embark 1pm

Embark in Stockholm, where waterways weave through a city built across fourteen islands, offering a fitting start for a voyage through the Baltic's historic ports.

July 16: Stockholm, Sweden

Spend a marvelous day discovering the lovely city and its beautiful buildings. Visit the medieval Gamla Stan and the elegant royal palace. Explore the wonderful parks and intricate alleyways that wind throughout the city.

July 17: Helsinki, Finland

Helsinki blends neoclassical architecture with modern Nordic design. The city's grand Senate Square, open markets, and seaside promenades reveal a capital shaped by both Swedish and Russian influences.

July 18: Tallinn, Estonia

Tallinn's medieval old town remains one of the best preserved in Europe. Cafés, artisan shops, and restored merchant houses now fill the medieval streets, blending centuries-old buildings with Estonia's modern cultural life.

July 19: Riga, Latvia

Riga, known for one of Europe's richest collections of Art Nouveau architecture, rises along the banks of the Daugava River. Ornate facades, grand boulevards, and lively squares point to a city long influenced by merchants, craftsmen, and the cultural exchange of the Baltic region.

July 20: Visby, Sweden

Visby sits on the island of Gotland, encircled by remarkably preserved medieval stone walls. Cobblestone lanes, church ruins, and historic buildings recall the town's prosperity during the Hanseatic League, a medieval alliance of Baltic trading ports.

July 21: Gdansk (Gdynia), Poland

Gdynia emerged in the 20th century as one of Poland's primary ports along the Baltic Sea. Nearby, the Westerplatte peninsula marks the site where World War II began, while a short trip to Gdansk reveals lively streets and historic market squares.

July 22: Karlskrona, Sweden ⚓

Karlskrona was founded in the late 17th century as Sweden's principal naval base. Today, visitors often explore the renowned Naval Museum Karlskrona, where historic ships and submarine exhibits reflect the maritime heritage of this UNESCO-listed city.

July 23: Berlin (Warnemünde), Germany

Warnemünde's seaside harbor is another gateway to Berlin, Germany's capital. In the heart of the city stand landmarks like the Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag, and Museum Island, where centuries of history and culture converge.

July 24: Cruising the North Sea

A day on the North Sea brings scenic coastal views, open horizons, and seabirds riding the wind. Time on deck invites a relaxed start to your journey while enjoying the ship's amenities.

July 25: Aarhus, Denmark

In Aarhus, modern harbor baths and public swimming areas are part of a lifestyle closely tied to the water. Locals gather along the shoreline to swim, linger, and take in the views, where design and daily life blend into a distinctly Danish rhythm.
